WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Introducing a tool to report difficulties accessing public venues and businesses.

The Disability Access Reporting Tool (DART) is an online form that triggers an email directly to owners/operators, informing them about access issues experienced by the user and reminding them of their obligations under anti-discrimination law.



HOW WILL IT HELP?

It's an opportunity for the premises to become aware of and address an access issue.

- Venues will be better educated
- Venues can address issues and avoid formal complaints
- Improved accessibility invites more visitors and customers
